



Solar Panels on Corvallis High School

Corvallis Community Power Club and its partner Tangerine Solar help locals "crowdfund" solar power projects on roofs in their community. EVERYONE can now take action on environmental preservation and security through *Community Supported Energy*. You buy a SunSlice™, which is 1 solar panel installed in a larger solar energy system in your community. Buying a SunSlice creates reliable, renewable energy for use by a community institution you value (like a school, church, or recreation club) and entitles you to a stream of rebates based on the energy your panel produces. Homeowners who do not have the ideal solar rooftop, condo residents, and even renters who want to reduce their community's carbon footprint and dependence on fossil fuels can now participate in the solar revolution.

How can the Corvallis community participate?

- **Community members** subscribe to a SunSlice that funds installation of a solar panel on a roof they choose. In return they receive rebates from the power their panel generates, up to the amount of their original purchase.
- **Property owners** lease their roof for solar power generation, receiving payment in the form of low-cost or no-cost solar electricity.
- **Solar Installers** sign up for our "Preferred Harvesters" program to bid on Club member solar projects.

What is Tangerine Solar's role?

- Help organize a "Community Power Club" that is majority-owned by local members.
- Secure rights to install solar power from community-minded property owners.
- Select a solar installer to assess available solar energy on the selected properties.
- Open SunSlice memberships to the community while complying with relevant securities laws.
- Ensure proper installation and maintenance of the solar energy systems from top local contractors.
- Distribute member rebates and property owner lease payments annually.
- Foster a continuing community around energy stewardship among project participants.
